GRANTS

We have been extremely fortunate with our Grant applications. Two have come through for our T Shirt promotion/performance shirts. We gratefully received \$1,000 from Pelorus Trust and Infinity Foundation granted us \$2,126.00. Your child will be given their T Shirt at the Southwards rehearsal (if not before).

We were also successful in receiving a grant of \$2000 from the Kapiti Coast Creative Community Grant Scheme. This will provide much needed assistance for the cost of the Southwards Concert.

CONCERT MUSIC

Your child will be receiving their concert music. The students will have pieces they are playing at Southwards in their respective orchestras. There will be 3 orchestras, junior, intermediate and senior. Your Tutor will tell your child which orchestra they are performing in. They will also have pieces to perform at the junior/intermediate performance at Kapiti College. These pieces are their individual item which will be performed only with the students who learn the same instrument as them. Senior students will be performing their individual item during the first half of the Southwards Concert.

This is a busy time of the KMC year and for the students to get the most out of their performances, they will need to practice their pieces.

For new students, performing may seem a bit daunting – this is a common reaction until they have actually experienced a KMC concert. Please get in touch with your child's tutor if you need help with supporting your child or if you are confused about the pieces they are learning.
