## INTRODUCTION TO MUSIC

Ages 5+ Tutor: Yemma Barsanti (Mon)\*

This course is for young children using singing, dancing, percussion, recorder and games to introduce the basics of music. We use a variety of other percussion instruments.

## RECORDER

Age 6+ Tutor: Yemma Barsanti (Tue)\*

Two years tuition on the Descant Recorder provides children with a thorough grounding in basic music principles of rhythm and notation. We recommend this course before learning a number of other instruments. No previous musical experience is necessary.

## VIOLIN

Age 5+ Tutor: Ann White (Mon, Tues & Thurs)\*

Learning this beautiful instrument will provide a thorough grounding in music. The Suzuki method of teaching is used. No previous musical experience is necessary.

## KEYBOARD

Age 7+ Tutor: Jill Duncan (Mon & Tues)\*

This course teaches Classical and Modern styles of music. Students will learn to read music and play in parts with others in the group. Students require a keyboard for practice at home and a music book. One year of recorder is recommended.

## PERCUSSION

Age 7+ Tutor: Karl Wagener (Mon)\*

This is a course teaching the theory of music structure and rhythm using a variety of percussion instruments and Cajons.

## DRUMS

Age 8+ Tutor: Karl Wagener (Mon)\*

One year of percussion is required before students can begin drum kit lessons.

## UKULELE

Age 7+ Tutor: Jill Duncan & Amanda Kemp (Mon & Tues)\*

A year of ukulele provides a grounding for learning the guitar. Students will need their own ukulele and tuner. No previous musical experience is necessary.

## CELLO

Age 9+ Tutor: Janet Holborow (Mon)\*

This instrument brings richness and depth to an ensemble. Pupils must exhibit the physical capacity to handle the instrument. No previous musical experience is necessary.

## GUITAR & BASS GUITAR

Age 8+ Tutor: Amanda Kemp (Mon, Tues & Thurs)\*

The teaching syllabus covers the basics of pop/rock, country/folk and classical to introduce chords, strumming, picking, tabs and basic music theory. Students should be physically capable of handling the instrument. 1 year of Ukulele is recommended. Students will need their own guitar and tuner.

## BRASS / TRUMPET / CORNET

Age 9+ Tutor: Merv Allison & John Lamond (Mon, Tues & Thurs)\*

Four big front teeth are needed for trumpet playing. A year of music tuition on Recorder is strongly recommended in preparation.

## CLARINET

Age 8+ Tutor: Shereelyn Harris (Tues)\*

A year of recorder is recommended before starting the Clarinet. Pupils must exhibit the physical capacity to handle the instrument.

## SAXOPHONE

Age 9+ Tutor: Shereelyn Harris (Tues)\*

Younger beginners are advised to start with a year of Recorder tuition or the Clarinet, which prepares them for the physical demands of this soul instrument.

## FLUTE

Age 8+ Tutor: Monica Verburg-VanEijck (Mon)\*

Explore the beautiful tone qualities of this versatile instrument. Flute can be an ideal transition from recorder lessons.

## GLEE CLUB

Age 8+ Tutor: Amanda Kemp (Mon)\*

A course offering vocal tuition in harmony and voice training where students will learn popular songs together.

## ENSEMBLE

Tutor: Ann White (Tues)\*

Entry into Ensemble will be by recommendation from tutors.

## ROCK BAND

Tutor: Amanda Kemp (Tues)\*

Entry into rock band will be by recommendation from tutors.

Entry into improvisation band will be by recommendation from tutors
